



Weekend Closures of State Route 4 Crosstown Freeway in Stockton

Closures begin Fridays at 10:00 p.m. and end Mondays at 5:00 a.m.

The Crosstown Big Fix, is collection of major rehabilitation work taking place on the State Route 4 (SR-4) Crosstown Freeway in Stockton, between Interstate 5 (I-5) and SR-99. Work is scheduled between April 2016 and December 2016.

Improvements will include: Replacing worn hinge bearing pads, installing new joint seals and sealing the bridge decks. Automated warning systems will be installed which include Closed Circuit TV's and Changeable Electronic Message Signs to warn drivers of upcoming hazards. Our maintenance crew will also perform several maintenance functions such as graffiti removal, debris and litter abatement, and landscaping.

Weekend closures will save 50 working construction days and reduce lane closures from 140 to only 15 days. Signed detours will be in place. Use SR-12 or SR-120 for detour access.

This work is scheduled to begin as listed, but is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and construction related issues.
